

Lines and Grids

This week was a great week for me. I managed my time very well and was able to get a lot of work done on my original work. However, I did notice some things that would be better done differently as I was working on my original work.

For starters, I had perspective paper, but not grid paper. So instead of working with easy gridded paper to draw out my floor plan, I made it all on triangle grid paper, which was a bit difficult and confusing, especially considering that the height of the triangle was not as long as the base. I got some grid paper this weekend, so I as do my final draw up, I will reconfigure it for regular gridded paper.

I also did not use a straightedge as I drew my first floor plan or as I drew the perspective drawing of the building from an angle. As I go forward with my original work, I will be using a straightedge to make my lines straight and even on all sketches and drawings.

Finally, I need to always keep in mind the scale of drawings. I have the scale on the triangle paper correct, but I need to be sure that everything remains to scale as I transfer my ideas from page to page.
